1. Baking contest entries must have a BCJLS Entry Label *and* recipe attached to the outside.
2. All entries in the foods categories must be accompanied by the recipe typed or hand written on 8 X 11" white paper or an index card, listing the complete recipe including pie crust recipes in pie category.
3. No prepackage mixes (biscuit, cornbread, muffins, cookies or icing) or purchased pie crusts or alcohol may be used in any Food Category. Decorated cakes/cupcakes may use small food safe props designed for use in edible decorating.
4. \*\*\*SPECIAL RULES: All entries in the Decorated Cake and cupcake category will be judged on creativity, originality and taste. A specific score card will be used for Division IV awarding the majority of the points to the exterior aesthetic of the entry.
5. No items requiring refrigeration will be accepted. Due to health regulations, no soft cheeses, including cream cheese, ricotta cheese and cottage cheese will be allowed in any category, except as a cooked ingredient.
6. All food entries MUST be on a sturdy nonreturnable plate and securely covered with clear plastic wrap.

7. All pies must be in an aluminum pie pan-
8. All loaves of bread must be a minimum of 4"X8" (rectangular) or 6" in diameter (round).
9. All cookies, candy, rolls, biscuits, etc., must contain thirteen (13) items. The Bexar County Junior Livestock Show will not be responsible for any non- disposable plates and platters.

1. **Only one entry per class in each division in the Photography Divisions (max 12)**
2. Photographs will be mounted on foam or mat board. ANY OTHER FRAMING/MOUNTING WILL DISQUALIFY AN ENTRY
3. Photo size can be no bigger than 8X10 no smaller than 4x6.
4. Photographs entered may be 35mm or digital with no special effects.
5. Photo Story must include a minimum of 3 photos, maximum of 6. Photo story can be no bigger than 22X24 inches in size. Photos should be mounted to depict a sequence or to communicate a message.
6. “Other” class includes digital manipulation and/or special effects.

## GARDENING AND HORTICULTURE, HORTICULTURE DIVISION

Category	Class	Description
A	1	Flowering plants, succulents, including terrariums

1. All entries must include on the BCJLS Entry Label the type of plant, date of purchase and date replanted.
2. Category A and B must be Live Rooted Plants.
3. All entries must fit within an area not larger than 5'x5'
4. Plant start date must be within 12 months of show.
5. Loose vegetables must be in a basket or container
6. Category 3 - Fresh Flower arrangements
  - a. Flowers need not be grown by exhibitor and may be retouched just prior to the public viewing in the event of wilting
  - b. This class may include one (1) accessory.
  - c. No artificial foliage or flower material may be used.
