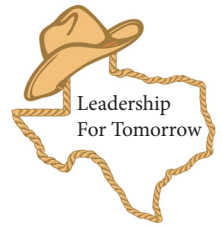

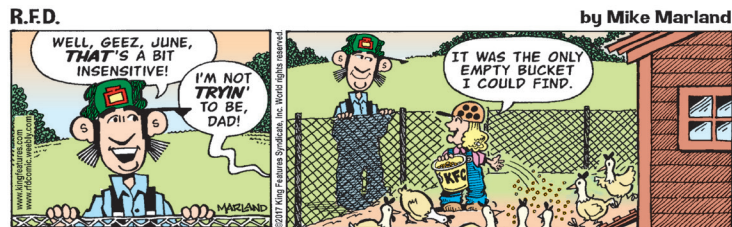

If the exhibitor cannot pick up their chicks, then a parent, guardian, project leader, Ag teacher, close friend may pick up the order. Those who pick up the chicks will be required to sign for the pick-up.
