### Eligibility - applicants must:


- 1. Be a Bexar County 4-H or FFA member in good standing.
- 2. Have exhibited at the Bexar County Junior Livestock Show (BCJLS) the previous two (2) years and be entered in this year's show.
- 3. Be a current graduating senior (graduating high school in 2025).
- 4. Attend college or a trade school in the fall semester of 2025.

#### **Rules**

- 1. The BCJLS will award up to twelve (12) \$500 scholarships at the 62nd Annual Auction of Champions before the auction begins on January 4, 2025 at the BCJLS Show Grounds. Winners **MUST be present** at the Auction of Champions to receive the scholarship.
- 2. Completed applications MUST be emailed to <a href="MarkH@bcjls.com">MarkH@bcjls.com</a>.
- 3. Completed applications must be received no later than 10:00pm on December 13, 2024. Late applications will not be accepted.
- 4. Applications must be typed (preferred) or neatly & legibly written. Academic information may be handwritten by high school counselor or principal.
- 5. Scholarship recipients are required to attend the BCJLS auction 1 hour prior to the posted time for the start of the auction to line up for presentation of the scholarship.

#### **Awarded Scholarships**

- Scholarship awards will be made directly to the recipient's chosen institution of higher learning, to be applied toward tuition, board and/or fees. Scholarship recipients must furnish a copy of their registration/schedule to the BCJLS treasurer by August 31, 2025. Please email a copy to treasurer@bcjls.com.
- 2. Registration/schedule must have the recipient's name, student ID and/or account number, and the name and mailing address of the institution of higher learning.
- 3. If copy of registration/schedule is not received by August 31, 2025, the recipient will forfeit the scholarship award. Note: All decisions of the scholarship committee will be final.
