

Bexar County Junior Livestock Show

Scholarship Application



Eligibility - applicants MUST:

1. Be a Bexar County 4-H or FFA member in good standing.
2. Have exhibited at the Bexar County Junior Livestock Show (BCJLS) the previous two (2) years and entered in this year's show.
3. Be a current graduating senior (graduating high school in 2026).
4. Attend an accredited college or a trade school in the fall semester of 2026. **Failure to enroll in the fall of 2026 will result in forfeiture of the scholarship.**

Rules

1. The BCJLS will award twelve (12) \$500 in scholarships at the 63rd Annual Auction of Champions before the auction begins on January 10, 2026 at the BCJLS Show Grounds. Winners **MUST be present** at the Auction of Champions to receive the scholarship.
2. Completed applications MUST be emailed to TeresaC@bcjls.com **no later than 10:00:00 pm on December 5, 2025. Late or incomplete applications will not be accepted.**
3. Applications must be typed (preferred) or neatly & legibly written. Academic information may be handwritten by a high school counselor or principal. **Illegible applications will be rejected.**
4. Judges will be anonymous from around the county and are not affiliated with the Current Board of Directors. The judges' decision will be final.

Awarded Scholarships

1. Scholarship recipients will be notified and are required to arrive at the BCJLS auction 1 hour prior to the posted time of the start of the auction to line up for presentation of the scholarship.
2. Scholarship will be paid directly to the recipient's school to be applied toward tuition, board, and/or fees.
3. Scholarship recipients must submit proof of registration or a valid school schedule, any paperwork required by the school, and instructions to the BCJLS treasurer by **August 31, 2026**. The paperwork must have the recipient's name, student ID and/or account number, and the name and mailing address of the school. Email paperwork to Treasurer@bcjls.com.
4. **If all paperwork is not received by August 31, 2026, the recipient will forfeit the scholarship award.** Note: All decisions of the scholarship committee will be final.
