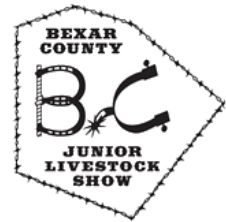

## **THE BEXAR COUNTY JUNIOR LIVESTOCK SHOW ANNUAL AUCTION OF CHAMPIONS IS THIS SATURDAY, JANUARY 10, 2026, at 9AM.**

January 5, 2026 – The Bexar County Junior Livestock Show (BCJLS) Auction of Champions is this Saturday, January 10, 2026 at 9am at the show grounds, 7701 FM 1346, San Antonio, TX. The Auction is open to the public with free parking. Free food and drinks are provided to live auction buyers.

The 63<sup>rd</sup> annual BCJLS was December 27-30, 2025. 871 exhibitors showed 1277 entries. 324 of those exhibitors made it to Saturday's Auction of Champions. Cattle, lambs, goats, poultry, rabbits, agricultural mechanical, creative arts, and swine projects were shown.

Sammy Perez, president of the BCJLS, said, "We had a tremendous Show this year thanks to all our supports, sponsors, exhibitors, judges, and board members. We are a county-only show. We are not open to the entire state of Texas. Raising livestock and making projects is expensive. For some kids this is the only place they can show their projects and hard work."

The BCJLS is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization that gives an opportunity for students in Bexar County to show their projects in a competitive arena. The exhibitors learn about production agriculture, welding and fabrication, and creative arts while receiving life lessons in finances, responsibility, leadership, and sportsmanship.

The Show was established in 1963. The Auction of Champions has existed in its current format for 25 years. Buyers, both corporate and individual, donate money to the kids in the Auction. It is not a traditional auction. Buyers do not actually bid against each other, nor do they receive an animal or project for their donation. Instead, buyers make donations to the youth exhibitors. The donations are tax deductible. Money can be donated live at the Auction this Saturday or [online at bcjls.org](https://bcjls.org).

Over the years, tens of thousands of our youth have passed their projects across the BCJLS auction block, earning money for their education and future. BCJLS is a success because of the commitment of business leaders, citizens, school district staff, parents, and students who recognize the lifelong value of FFA and 4-H.
